
Information commonly found on a prescription label



- Name, address and telephone number of the pharmacy. Website information if applicable.
- 2. Serial number assigned to the prescription, drug quantity, number of refills and when refills expire.
- 3. Prescriber name, date prescription is filled, date of when drug should be discarded. Name of pharmacist who signed off on the prescription, and initials of the person who dispensed the medication. Manufacturer of the medication is also included.
- 4. Description of what the medication looks like.
- 5. Name and address of the patient.
- 6. Name and strength of the medication dispensed.
- 7. Directions for use.
- 8. Cautionary statements.
